Session One

Working with Outside Counsel to Control Litigation Costs

This presentation will deal with a variety of means and methods to allow outside counsel to better understand and control costs associated with litigation. The presentation, which will include a panel of A.C.C. members, will address case budgeting methods, decision tree analysis for assessing risks associated with litigation, effective management and oversight of the litigation process through use of intranet technology, and alternative billing options.

Session Two

Protecting Trade Secrets and Effective Utilization and Enforcements of Noncompete Agreements

This presentation will address common problems encountered in protecting trade secrets and enforcement of noncompete agreements, and offer recommended methods of dealing with those problems.

Session Three

Mock Trial Presentation

This interactive presentation provides attendees with a video reenactment of openings, witness testimony, and closings from an actual labor and employment case involving sexual harassment and retaliation. Attendees are then divided up into several jury panels, receiving jury instructions and verdict forms, and asked to render verdicts. A group discussion comparing the verdicts rendered by the group with verdicts obtained from actual jurors, and addressing effective methods for limiting and avoiding sexual harassment complaints in the workplace, follows.
